



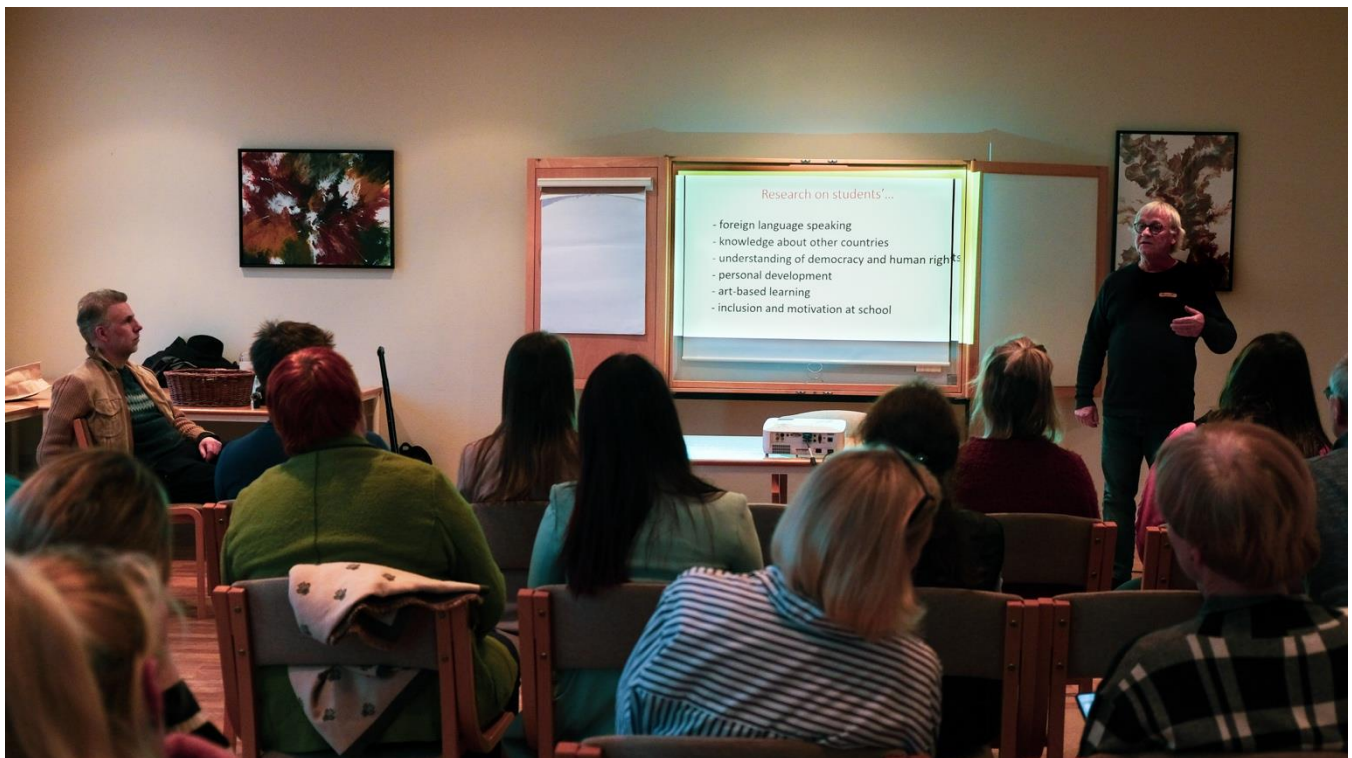
**Report at annual-meeting for association Exchanges for All at meeting 10.1.2023

This meeting is a keystone in our international school-cooperation, which consists of 3 basic elements:

- a) January Evaluation- & Planning-Meeting
- b) May exchanges
- c) September exchanges

We succeeded in finally during 2022 to implement again physical exchanges, but, we came out with a minus for these 2 exchanges, which basically was due to:

- a) Increasing prices for food and for transportation
- b) The lack of proper planning, as many projects were postponed for 2 years and so not part of conscious plan
- c) Many new partners away from the old travelling-route along the south side of The Baltic Sea: Rostock-Wejherowo-Klaipeda-Liepaja



It is a great advantage of being a solid, sustainable cooperation, that we are having also the possibility of maintain a minus from a previous year



The conclusions are a.o.:

- a. Necessary with more than one funding source, so e.g. both Nordplus & E+ or an private funding as A.P. Møller Fonden
- b. More transparency in the planning & reporting = more non-depending to B.O.
 - i. Specific schools and persons there are following specific projects and are responsible for the final reports.

A couple of more things are necessary for the future:

- ✓ Written evaluations from all students and teachers
- ✓ Papers on walls at exchanges showing where the funding comes from
- ✓ Online-camp-meetings for students before and after exchanges (between)
- ✓ Joint, national, preparation of Intercultural Evening
- ✓ More involvement of group-leaders:
 - Taking part in all circles & staff-meetings
 - Sharing tasks of morning-circles
 - Being responsible for contact to local media
 - Being responsible for intro to “Stop Climate Changes”
 - Being responsible for only English speaking in “public” areas.
